There are many brands of acrylic paints available. Perhaps the best company is Liquitex, and Golden, however for starting out buy less expensive paints.

Paints can be purchased locally at A.C. Moore.

If you don't mind driving, there is Jerry's Artist Outlet, (Essex Green Shopping Center)495 Prospect Ave, West Orange, NJ 07052. They have excellent prices and it is an art adventure.

For purchasing online there is Blick and Jerrys Artsarama.

I recommend, if you are just starting out to purchase "Liquitex Basics"Purchase any size tube that your budget allows, however the titanium white should be 5oz. size, all other sizes are 2oz. tubes.

List of colors:

1. Titanium White(5oz. tube)
2. Mars Black or Ivory Black
3. Ultramarine Blue
4. Phthlo Green
5. Dioxazine Purple
6. Cadmium Red Light Hue
7. Cadmium Yellow Light Hue

Equipment

Don't go crazy about the type of brushes you will need. Just get various sizes of two types:

- flat bristle brushes
- soft nylon or hair
- Cheap 1 inch flat brush(for covering areas quickly)
- Palette knives for mixing and/or painting.
- Disposable paper palette and/or Styrofoam coldcut trays.
- Any size stretched canvas or canvas boards.
- One inch wide masking tape.
- Cans, cups, glasses, for holding water.
- Paper towels or rags.
